





Pentecost - Shavuot

Shavuot sha-VU-ot – Festival of Weeks, celebrated on the 50th day after Passover, also Pentecost, Greek for "50"


One of Three Pilgrimage Festivals

Passover – Deliverance of Hebrews from Egypt

Shavuot – Festival of Weeks, celebrated ONE DAY

Sukkot – Festival of Booths, recalling 40 years wandering

Shavuot celebrated the covenants with Noah and Moses Shavuot giving of Torah



Pentecost - Shavuot

Encyclopedia Judaica: possible Pharisees made Shavuot commemorate the giving of the Torah before Christ, believing as they did the Torah was given at Sinai on the 50th day after the Exodus, something the Sadducees denied.

Yet, Philo and Josephus make no reference to Shavuot as commemorating the time of the giving of the Torah.

AD 200+ Jews celebrated anniversary Torah given at Sinai

"Tongues" = glōssais - 15x in the NT – 60+ other conjugation.

Clear in Acts 2 the use is the languages of many people
In 1 Corinthians chapters 12-14 = very same glōssais refers to an unintelligible "tongue/languages" requiring a gift of interpretation

Pentecostals are most famous for their use of "gift of tongues"

- Many trace Pentecostal Church to Agnes Ozman in Topeka KS in 1901, who first spoke in tongues & they welcomed the Holy Spirit
- Catholic believe on January 1, 1901—at the SAME TIME— Pope Leo XIII prayed to the Holy Spirit, singing Veni Creator Spiritus in a window in St. Peter's Basilica in Rome

Most Baptists & Protestants don't use or believe in gift of tongues

- ✓ Acts 10:46 & 19:6 "heard them speak in tongues & prophesy" (no interpretation)
- ✓ Rom 3:13 tongues for languages "with their tongues they used deceit"
- ✓ After A.D. 100—NOT any use for tongues the first 1,800+ years of church





language διαλέκτω – 6x – word "dialect" – 42x other uses KJV often translates διαλέκτω as tongues – same as glōssais

MIRACLE gift of Holy Ghost or Holy Spirit to the Church Beginning of the Church with Confusion of Babel *suspended*

Early Church BONUS

Acts 28, Paul & Rome AD 63 - AD 64, Nero burns Rome

Quo Vadis, 1951 epic MGM film adapted from the classic novel Quo Vadis (1896) by Henryk Sienkiewicz. Marcus Vinicius, a Roman patrician, falls for Lygia, a Christian, and he attempts to save her from Nero's increasing insanity.

"Quo Vadis"—"Where are you going?" refers to a Christian tradition of St Peter from the apocryphal Acts of Peter (Vercelli Acts XXXV). As Peter flees Rome, he meets the risen Jesus and asks Jesus "Quo vadis?" Jesus replies, "Romam eo iterum crucifigi"—"I am going to Rome to be crucified again." Peter gains the courage to return to Roman and his ministry, and eventually to be crucified.

Unworthy to be crucified as his Lord was, he asked to be crucified upside-down.

The Church of Domine Quo Vadis in Rome is built where, according to legend, the meeting took place between Peter and Jesus.
