C. H. Spurgeon called Acts 15:11 the "Apostle's Creed" in sermon #765, in 1867 volume, Metropolitan Tabernacle

Inimitable Spurgeon said on Acts 15:11:

You notice it begins with, "We believe."

We will call it, then, the "Apostle's Creed," and

we may rest assured that it has quite as clear a right to

that title as that highly esteemed composition ... called the

"Nicene, or Apostle's Creed."

Peter is speaking for the rest, and he says, "We believe."

Well, Peter, what do you believe?

We are all attention. Peter's answer is [Acts 15:11],

"We believe that through the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ

we shall be saved, even as they."



C. H. Spurgeon called Acts 15:11 the "Apostle's Creed"

There is a great deal of talk in our day—foolish, vainglorious, idiotic, senseless talk, as we think, about apostolical succession.

Another thing is very clear here.

The apostle did not believe in self-righteousness.

Creed of the world is, "Do your best, and it will be all right ...

To question this is treason against the pride of human nature, which evermore clings to salvation by its own merits.

Every man is born a Pharisee. Self-confidence is bred in the bone....
Why, you know, we must all live as well as we can,
every man according to his own light;
and if every man follows out his own conscience,
as near as may be, surely it will be well with us?"

That is NOT what Peter said.

C. H. Spurgeon called Acts 15:11 the "Apostle's Creed"

That is NOT what Peter said.

Peter did NOT say, "We believe that through doing our best, we shall be saved like other people."

He did not even say, "We believe that if we act according to our light, God will accept that little light....

NO! the apostle strikes out quite another track, and solemnly affirms,

Acts 15:11 "We believe that through the GRACE of our Lord Jesus Christ

"we shall be saved"

NOT through our good works, **NOT** through anything that we do,

NOT by the merit of anything which we feel or perform,

or promise to perform, but by GRACE ... by the free favor of God.

"Perish each thought of human pride—Let God alone be magnified."



OTHER believers, to go UP TO Jerusalem to see the apostles & elders about this.


³ The CHURCH sent them on their way ... traveled through Phoenicia & Samaria, they told how the Gentiles had been converted.

THEN these marvelous words:

What NEWS?

Gentile Conversion!





ἐκκλησίας = called out = Assembly = Church

200+ variations, singular, plural, possessive, etc.

MEANS a gathering of citizens called out from their homes into some public place

an assembly

You'll Come, Gather 'Round

NIV & KJV translate ἐκκλησίας "assembly" in

19:32 The ASSEMBLY [Church?] was in confusion: Some were shouting one thing, some another. Most of the people did not even know WHY they were there.

"Assembly" is evolving into "Church" = believers

Elder = Greek *presbuteros* = 66x in N.T. Yes, from which we get *Presbyterian*

Shaken up, boiled down ... and simply Older Leadership

Before Paul & Barnabas LEAVE Pisidia and come back to Syrian Antioch

23 Paul and Barnabas appointed *ELDERS* for them in EACH CHURCH and,

with prayer and fasting, committed them to the Lord, in whom they had put their trust.

Later ... the "elders" ... EVOLVE

By Paul's 1 Timothy & Titus 1 = we see "Overseer"

See the term "Pastor" for shepherd

But as Acts unfolds ... the "Church"


Still evolving ... Led by the Holy Spirit

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v. 15:5 — "Pharisee Party" is starting fights

Believers of the "Pharisee Party" contend

Gentiles MUST be circumcised AND they must keep the Law of Moses

Then a GREAT landmark verse 14:6

But circumcision allied Timothy to Paul

Yet, as oddly, in Galatians 2:3, Paul says

Yet not even Titus, who was with me, was compelled to be circumcised,

even though he was a Greek.

Wow—Greek Christians PRESSURED to be CUT

Nicene Creed

First Council of Nicaea, A.D. 325

We believe in one God, the Father Almighty, Maker of all things visible and invisible. And in one Lord Jesus Christ, the Son of God, begotten of the Father [the onlybegotten; that is, of the essence of the Father, God of God,] Light of Light, very God of very God, begotten, not made, consubstantial with the Father;

By whom all things were made [both in heaven and on earth];

Who for us men, and for our salvation, came down and was incarnate and was made man;

He suffered, and the third day he rose again, ascended into heaven;

From thence he shall come to judge the quick and the dead.

And in the Holy Ghost.

First Council of Constantinople, A.D. 381

We believe in one God, the Father Almighty, Maker of heaven and earth, and of all things visible and invisible.

And in one Lord Jesus Christ, the only-begotten Son of God, begotten of the Father before all worlds (æons), Light of Light, very God of very God, begotten, not made, consubstantial with the Father;

by whom all things were made;

who for us men, and for our salvation, came down from heaven, and was incarnate by the Holy Ghost and of the Virgin Mary, and was made man;

he was crucified for us under Pontius Pilate, and suffered, and was buried, and the third day he rose again, according to the Scriptures, and ascended into heaven, and sitteth on the right hand of the Father;

from thence he shall come again, with glory, to judge the quick and the dead;

whose kingdom shall have no end.

And in the Holy Ghost, the Lord and Giver of life, who proceedeth from the Father, who with the Father and the Son together is worshiped and glorified, who spake by the prophets.

In one holy catholic and apostolic Church; we acknowledge one baptism for the remission of sins; we look for the resurrection of the dead, and the life of the world to come. Amen.

Apostle's Creed - evolved from Nicaea 325 & Constantinople 381

I believe in God,
the Father almighty,
Creator of heaven and earth,
and in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord,
who was conceived by the Holy Spirit,
born of the Virgin Mary,
suffered under Pontius Pilate,
was crucified, died and was buried;
he descended into hell;

on the third day he rose again from the dead; he ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of God the Father almighty; from there he will come to judge the living and the dead.

I believe in the Holy Spirit,
the holy catholic Church,
the communion of saints,
the forgiveness of sins,
the resurrection of the body,
and life everlasting.

Oh my oh my ... so much missing

12 Whole assembly became silent as they listened to Barnabas and Paul telling about the signs and wonders God had done among the Gentiles through them.

WHOLE First Missionary Journey

13 When they finished, James spoke up. "Brothers," he said, "listen to me.

James starts WITH Peter's speech ...

What happened with Paul & Barnabas

May have been assumed ... oh well





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15:12-22 Paul & Barnabas Testify about First Journey

James ... the brother of Jesus, starts with a verse that doesn't call attention to itself

God first intervened to choose a people for his name from the Gentiles.

Scofield Bible, in a note on v. 14, said:

"Dispensationally ... the most important passage in the N.T."

Gentile converts ... INCLUDED in promise

to rebuild David's throne ...





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15:12-22 Paul & Barnabas Testify about First Journey

Therefore ... after a very clipped version of James' message ...

19 "It is my judgment ...
20 Instead we should write to them ...

Then the apostles and elders, with the whole church, decided to choose some of their own men and send them to Antioch WITH Paul and Barnabas.

They chose Judas (called Barsabbas) and Silas, men who were leaders among the believers.



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15:23-29 Great Jerusalem LETTER

COUNCIL sends LETTER

23 With them they sent the following letter: The apostles and elders, your brothers,

To the Gentile believers in Antioch, Syria and Cilicia: Greetings.

- ²⁴ We have heard ... [of bad knuckleheads]... troubling your minds by what they said.
- 25 ... with dear friends Barnabas & Paul—
- ²⁶ men who have risked their lives ...
- ²⁷ sending Judas & Silas to confirm ...





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15:23-29 Great Jerusalem LETTER

Preface on Circumcision Salvation:

28 It seemed good to the Holy Spirit and to us not to BURDEN you with anything beyond the following requirements:

The Message:

²⁹ You are to abstain from food sacrificed to idols, from blood, from the meat of strangled animals and from sexual immorality.

You will do well to avoid these things. FAREWELL.

What a relief ...

CAN be Saved WITHOUT Circumcision





15:23-29 Great Jerusalem LETTER

- Paul ATTACKS Peter for being "afraid" of the Circumcised Believers in Galatians 2
 - ✓ Some believe Paul is referring to Acts 11
 - ✓ Others believe Paul is referring to Acts 15

Whatever, Paul DRILLS his point in Galatians 2:16

Not by Works of the Law

Paul refines more Romans 2:17-29

Rom 2:29 No, a person is a Jew who is one inwardly; & circumcision is circumcision of the heart, by the Spirit, not by the written code.

Being SAVED is by Grace & Faith ALONE




Many male BELIEVERS wondered & feared Must I be Circumcised?

- Core of the Acts 15 Council's Great Letter is Very Simply ... on circumcision
 - * For believers in Christ—NOT required
 - For Jews, it WAS required, Yet Not to be Saved
 - * Circumcision is NOT required NOW
 - * Avoid Pagan Meat & Strangled Animals
 - * Avoid Sexual Immorality
- a Great Relief to MANY male believers

CAN be SAVED without Circumcision





15:30-35 Head Back to Antioch

Off they go ... Great Paul & company ...

30 So the men ... went DOWN to Antioch, where they gathered the CHURCH- ASSEMBLY together and delivered the letter.

31 People read it and were glad for its encouraging message.

Judas & Silas, who themselves were prophets, said much to encourage and strengthen the believers....

Judas & Silas Go back to Jerusalem



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15:30-35 Head Back to Antioch

35 But Paul and Barnabas *REMAINED* in Antioch, where they and many others taught & preached the word of the Lord.

Now that is the NARRATIVE ...

But the GRAVITY of the situation THEN I am sure escapes most of us ...

Let me offer you a recap ... a closer look at

Acts 11 informs us on Acts 15... this problem has been simmering for two decades

Recall that Peter struggled in Acts 11





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Acts 11, Apostles & Believers heard about Gentiles HEARING gospel

11:2 So when Peter went up to Jerusalem, the circumcised believers CRITICIZED him


11:3 and said, "You went into the house of UNCIRCUMCISED men & ate with them."

What? ... how did they KNOW?

Are there "Circumcision Inspectors"?

Peter retells his Joppa 3-fold rooftop vision

Yet ... sometime after this Paul confronted Peter "to his face" in Galatians 2

Paul tells us clearly ... Peter was no ROCK Galatians 2:12

For before certain men came from James, he used to eat with the Gentiles.

But when they arrived, he began to draw back and separate himself from the Gentiles

because he was afraid of those who belonged to the circumcision group.

Peter ... the ROCK ... hah!

More like a Mud Pie





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Circumcision PROBLEM REAL

15:1 – folks from Judea in Antioch say:

"Unless you are circumcised ...
you CANNOT be SAVED."

YIKES - Paul & Barnabas MUST ARGUE . . . and they MUST go to Jerusalem for help

While reporting in Jerusalem, look see:

15:5 BELIEVERS who belonged to the party of the Pharisees stood up and said,

"The Gentiles MUST be circumcised & required to KEEP the law of Moses."





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We MUST understand something ... What about the women? ... NOT considered But there's another problem ... a BURDEN



Henry Ward Beecher, 1813-1887

- ✓ Son of evangelist Lyman Beecher
- ✓ Brother to Harriet Beecher Stowe, who achieved worldwide fame with *Uncle Tom's Cabin* (1852)
- ✓ 1839, Pastor of Second Presbyterian Church of Indianapolis – growing to largest in the city
- ✓ 1847, Pastor of Plymouth Congregational Church in Brooklyn, New York – invited Abe Lincoln to his church
- ✓ Became one of the greatest national speakers, touring the U.S.
- ✓ Beecher opposed slavery ...
- ✓ After Civil War, Beecher supported women's right to vote

they begin to discuss the habits of the bird, its size, color ... eggs ... one pulls out of his pocket a treatise ...


another of Audubon ... dispute till at length ... quarrel ... get RED in the face & woods ring with their CONFLICT ...

the entranced philosophers subdued and ashamed of their quarrel shut their books and walk home without a word




