


Paul explains John's vs. Jesus' Baptism:

- ⁴ Paul said, "John's baptism was a baptism of repentance. He told the people to believe in the one coming after John, that is, in Jesus."
- ⁵ On hearing this, they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus.

Article VII. Baptism & the Lord's Supper

Christian baptism is the immersion of a believer in water in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. It is an act of obedience symbolizing the believer's faith in a crucified, buried, and risen Saviour, the believer's death to sin, the burial of the old life, and the resurrection to walk in newness of life in Christ Jesus. It is a testimony to his faith in the final resurrection of the dead. Being a church ordinance, it is prerequisite to the privileges of church membership and to the Lord's Supper.

Faith in PAST Christ's Death, Burial, & Resurrection


Faith in PRESENT Believer's Death, Burial of sin, & Resurrection in New Life this side of Heaven

Home to the Temple of Artemis ... 4x larger than the Parthenon in Athens


One of Seven Wonders of the Ancient World

Alexander financed rebuild - stood for 600 years


Destroyed by Goths in A.D. 263






