



Paul is Christianity's Superstar

Smartest, Most Prolific ... Best Liked teacher

Most Hated by Holy Jews – hate increasing for 6,500 miles

Next day ... Paul sees James & Elders

**CONTROVERSY ... Jews spread RUMORS** 

Yes again, circumcision NOT required to be SAVED

Jews LIED that Paul preached AGAINST Law and AGAINST circumcision ... they just LIED

James & Elders ask Paul to purify himself to

SHOW there is No Truth to the Jews' LIES



21:17-25 Paul Visits James, et al Paul joins in purification ... then That is, Paul follows the Jewish Law Regarding Gentiles themselves ...

v. 25 James recalls Acts 15, "We have written"

# Jerusalem Council Decision Definitive

So definitive ... it is recalled

Paul brings Greeks into the Temple

Non-Jews – DEATH to enter temple

Holy Jews CLAIM such ... Stir MUCH





# John Bunyan's *The Pilgrim's Progress*published in 1678 –

- ✓ Most Read next to the Bible for 100 years
- ✓ Translated into over 200 languages
- ✓ Masterful Allegory of the Christian Journey
- ✓ Some have said no other book has had a broader range of influence, esp. given the number of major authors it touched
- ✓ Bunyan wrote it in Bedfordshire County JAIL for violating Conventicle Act of 1664, holding religious services OUTSIDE Church of England

C.S. Lewis wrote The Pilgrim's Regress—An Allegorical Apology for Christianity Reason and Romanticism (London: 1933, revised 1943).

Man named Christian leaves his "City of Destruction" with a Great Burden on his Back


Christian is going to the Celestial City ...

On the road Christian meets, is joined by, & parts with a host of intriguing people whose NAMES betray their characters

Christian falls into the Slough of Despond ... a mirey swamp of doubts, fears, etc.

Christian is pulled out by a nice fellow named HELP Mr. Worldly Wiseman gives not-so-good advice

To the town, Vanity ... with a Vanity Fair all year long


Bunyan details all sorts of nefarious trades & people

They are arrested, beaten, smeared with dirt, put into a CAGE








- ✓ Studied under Gamaliel (leading scholar of day)






