


Jews seek to *KILL* him

Acts 9:22, Saul grew more & more powerful & baffled the Jews living in Damascus by proving that Jesus is the Messiah.


9:23 ... after many days, Jews plot to KILL

Jews watch gate to KILL Paul




- 9:29 ... as Paul talked ... tried to KILL him

Romans 15 Paul desired to go Spain

Several indicate Paul was beheaded

Eusebius of Caesarea, in his Church History (AD 320)

Few that Paul was martyred LATER ... somewhere


SEVERAL indicate Paul was

Remember this portrait of St. Paul
We do NOT know what he looked like
Yet we know his work, writings, LIFE
I can imagine ... do image ...

That Paul often wondered as he wrote each dear letter, Romans, 1 & 2 Cor. Galatians, Ephesians, Philippians, Colossians 1 & 2 Thess, 1 & 2 Timothy, Titus, Philemon

I DO IMAGINE that many, many times as Paul wrote, Paul wondered if

HE WOULD LIVE TO WRITE ANOTHER

Tradition says Paul was beheaded in Rome

Likely part of Nero's persecution after Nero burned Rome in A.D. 64



Apostle Paul, c. 1657 by Rembrandt (1606-69)

One legend of Paul's beheading in Rome is
Where San Paolo alle Tre Fontane now stands

Italian for "St Paul at the Three Fountains" First in 5th Cent. ... rebuilt 1599


Legend has it ... when Paul's head dropped
It bounced 3 times ... each time it touched
a fountain of water burst forth

Acts 27 ... long narrative on journey to Malta


v. 8, Arrive at Fair Havens, southern Crete Paul warns of disaster, but Centurion listens to ship captain

Not good to winter at Fair Havens ... Sail On

v. 14 ... caught by "Northeaster" wind

Hurricane blows the ship for DAYS


They lower the Sea Anchor







v. 14 ... caught by "Northeaster" wind Greek is *Euroclydon* ... only place in N.T. "euros" = "east wind" ... "clydon" = "waves" Similar to "Europa" - Phoenician Princess **Europe** – variously derived from Greek: wide-eyed, broad, wide-gazing Akkadian: going down Phoenician: west Euroclydon ... v. 14 only place in N.T. ... Violent East Wind ... stirs up wave






v. 14 ... "Northeaster" Greek is Euro-clydon ...

Clydon – nowhere in N.T. – yet root for words in

Eph. 4:14, Then we will no longer be infants, tossed back and forth by the WAVES, and

blown here and there by every wind of teaching ... cunning & craftiness of people....

James 1:6, one who doubts is like a WAVE of the sea, blown and tossed by the wind.





v. 14 ... caught by Euroclydon ...

witness to all of Paul's prayers & miracles







They throw the cargo overboard


On the third day, they throw tackle overboard


When neither sun nor stars appeared for many days and the storm continued raging, we finally gave up all hope of being saved.

Charles Spurgeon says of 27:20

Multitudes of persons are sailing in what they think to be the good Ship of Self-Righteousness: they are expecting they shall get to heaven in her.

But she never did carry a soul safely into the Fair Haven yet, and she never will....

when a terrific tempest overtakes this vessel ...

I am glad ... old ship parts timber from timber,

when she goes aground & breaks to pieces....





I recollect very well when that terrific Euroclydon blew on my vessel.

It was as good a vessel as any of you have....

Sails wanted mending, and

here and there she wanted a little touch of paint, but for all that she was

sea-worthy & fit to be registered

- ^{7:23} Last night an ANGEL of the God to whom I belong and whom I serve stood beside me
- ²⁴ said, 'Do not be afraid, Paul. You must stand trial before Caesar; and God has graciously given you the lives of all who sail with you.'
- ²⁵ So keep up your courage, men, for I have faith in God that it will happen just as he told me.
- ²⁶ Nevertheless, we must run aground....

Paul warns Centurion ... Stay in the Ship!







On Malta ... Chief Official of island welcomes
His father is very ill – Paul prays for him, heals him
Then verse Acts 28:9

⁹ When this had happened, the rest of the sick on the island came and were *CURED*.

Bear in mind, Luke is Paul for the roughly 1,700 miles from Caesarea to Malta – on a ship

Except for Malta & after Malta, No more healings

No more demons cast out – there's a noticeable reduction

After Three Months ... they are well provisioned

Sail on an Alexandrian ship with figureheads of twin gods Castor and Pollux

Sail to Syracuse - stay three days there



Alexandrian ship with FIGUREHEADS
of twin gods Castor & Pollux
When together, they are called Dioscuri
Twin sons of Zeus, who
as a swan seduced Leda

- ✓ Homer portrays them as mortals
- ✓ Patrons of Sailors
- ✓ Appear as St. Elmo's Fire

 Electrical discharges from

 points on ship or plane

Lot of help Castor & Pollux gave the sailors to Malta



Forum was full of boatmen & cheating innkeepers.



28:15-20 The Journey – Paul Welcomed, Calls Jewish Leaders

¹⁵ Brothers & sisters there had heard that we were coming, and they traveled as far as the

Forum of Appius & Three Taverns to meet us.

At the sight of these people Paul thanked God and was encouraged.

16 When we got to Rome, Paul was allowed to live by himself, with a soldier to guard him.



28:15-20 Paul Calls Jewish Leaders

17 Three days later he called together the local Jewish leaders.

When they had assembled, Paul said to them:

"My brothers, although I have done nothing against our people or against the customs of our ancestors, I was arrested in Jerusalem and handed over to the Romans.

They examined me & wanted to release me, because I was NOT GUILTY of any crime deserving DEATH.



28:15-20 Paul Calls Jewish Leaders


Of course ... we know what follows:

19 The Jews objected, so I was compelled to make an appeal to Caesar.

I certainly did not intend to bring any charge against my own people.

²⁰ For this reason I have asked to see you and talk with you.

It is because of the hope of Israel that I am bound with this chain.



28:21-23 Paul "Dawn to Dusk" on Kingdom

21 They replied, "We have not received any letters from Judea concerning you, and none of our people who have come from there has reported or said anything bad about you.

²² But we want to hear what your views are, for we know that people EVERYWHERE are talking against this sect."



28:21-23 "Dawn to Dusk" on Kingdom

23 They arranged to meet Paul on a certain day, and came in even larger numbers to the place where he was staying.

He witnessed to them from morning till evening, explaining about the kingdom of God,

AND from the Law of Moses and from the Prophets he tried to persuade them about Jesus.



²⁴ Some were convinced by what he said, but others would not believe.

²⁵ They disagreed among themselves & began to leave after Paul had made this final statement:

"The Holy Spirit spoke the truth to your ancestors when he said through Isaiah the prophet:

Paul quotes from Isaiah 6:9-10



26 " 'Go to this people and say, "You will be ever hearing but never understanding; you will be ever seeing but never perceiving."

For this people's heart has become calloused; they hardly hear with their ears, and they have closed their eyes.

Otherwise they might see with their eyes, hear with their ears, understand with their hearts & turn, and I would heal them.'



28 "Therefore, I want you to know that God's salvation has been sent to the Gentiles, and they will listen!"

Gentiles ... non-Jews ... THEY WILL LISTEN





Paul with a bodyguard in Rome, trusted like no other trustee was ever trusted

Now spreading the gospel from the **HEART** of Roman Empire

To many

Rome **Master** of the KNOWN World



After two years, Paul may have been beheaded in Rome ... OR Paul may have travelled to Spain ... Because of the Church Fathers' writings ... Likely Paul was beheaded SOMEWHERE Perhaps, and even likely in Rome ... Given all the travels ... tumults ... travails

How do you suppose Paul met his end?

Perhaps right before the sword came down ...

Perhaps an Angel visited Paul



Maybe it was the SAME Angel that visited Paul when Euroclydon tore up the sea

Now as Paul's darkest hour came ...

Perhaps Paul's Guardian Angel whispered in Paul's ear,

"Here ... Good & Faithful Servant
Here is a little salve for your neck
For your journey ...
You will not feel a thing
Little Salve for your journey HOME"



Paul's Guardian Angel whispered once more in Paul's ear,
"Though Good & Faithful Servant ..."

Then 1880 lyrics of Will L. Thompson fill the air round about Paul

Paul's Guardian Angel lightly whispers:

Softly and tenderly, Jesus is calling, Calling for you and for me;

See, on the portals
He's waiting & watching,
Watching for you & for me.



Acts 27:31 ends – Paul proclaimed the kingdom of God and taught about the Lord Jesus Christ—with all boldness and without hindrance!

After 2 vrs. Paul is tied & sword held high

After 2 yrs, Paul is tied & sword held high an Angel whispering calms Paul's heart ...

Come HOME, come HOME,
You who are weary, come HOME ...

As the Angel touched the tongue of Isaiah some 700 years before
