Barnabas found Saul in Tarsus, and they served together in Antioch.

AD 41-49

Claudius became emperor in Rome. He later expelled all Jews from Rome (AD 49-50).

44

James became the first of Jesus's disciples to be martyred.

Herod Agrippa died.

45

Epistle of James written.

47

Saul (Paul), Barnabas, and John Mark began their first missionary journey from Antioch.

49

First church council at Jerusalem affirmed that Gentiles did not have to accept the law to become Christ followers.

Paul and Silas began their second missionary journey.

Paul wrote his epistle to the Galatian churches.

AD 50-62

50s

Matthew, Mark, and Luke wrote their Gospels.

53

Paul left on his third missionary journey.

54

Nero became emperor in Rome.

57-59

Paul was arrested in Jerusalem and eventually imprisoned in Caesarea. During this time, Paul appealed to have his case heard by Caesar in Rome.

59

Paul began his journey to Rome.

Paul and those with him survived a shipwreck in Malta.

60-62

Paul lived under house arrest in Rome.
