Church Father Theodoret (A.D. 393–466), Bishop of Cirrhus near N. T. Antioch ... commented on this:

The sun, by the force of its heat,

moistens the wax and dries the clay,

softening the one and hardening the other;

and as this produces opposite effects by the same power, so, through the longsuffering of God, which reaches to all,

some receive good and others evil, some are softened and others hardened.

To better grapple with Pharaoh's hard HEART

We should look at the Role of Snakes in Ancient Israel & Egypt?

Ancient Egyptians Revered snakes ... listen to this!

Cosmic Snake Gods sought to destroy ... and to help

Wadjet – hooded cobra goddess on Pharaoh's Crown over Lower Egypt ... snake god helped PROTECT Pharaoh

That is not all ... Canaanites worshipped snakes ... several snake symbols, lot of nudity ... bloody, killing young & old

Leviticus 11:29-31, snakes are unclean in long list of animals

You know then ... what this means ...

If the Exodus is c. 1447 B.C. ... that is 3,000 years before A.D. 1492

1,000 years before the Golden Age of Greece ...

To the Egyptians & Canaanites

Hebrews are WEIRD w only One God

Mythical Path of snakes crosses many cultures for many millennia

Geoffrey Parrinder, Encountering World Religions (NY, 1987; pg. 128), on reincarnation in primitive Africa:

Reincarnation ... in African expressions is rebirth on to this warm earth to perpetuate the family of the past, whereas in Asia it is often an effort to get away from the sufferings of this life into the indescribable bliss of Nirvana.

A symbol of rebirth in African art is the snake, which sheds its skin to go on living, and which with its tail in its mouth is an apt representation of an endless circle, a ring of eternity.

WORLD ... the COSMOS ... what is above in the HEAVENS

What is below in Sheol or Hades in 1447 B.C. ... WEIRD IDEAS


Greek writer Lucian of Samosata (A.D. 125–180) calls Alexander of Abonuteichos (105-170) a SWINDLER

This 2nd century Alexander was a cultist who made a puppet of the snake god Glycon ... that could MOVE

Lucian described the statue as having

a serpent head of linen, which had something of a human look, was all painted up, and appeared very lifelike. It would open and close its mouth by means of horse hairs, and a forked black tongue like a snake's, also controlled by horse hairs, would dart out.







- 2. Ex. 4:3-5 long dialogue on Mt. Sinai, God tells Moses to throw his staff on the ground—poof, into a snake—Moses runs God tells Moses to grab it by the tail ...
- 3. Num. 21:6-9 Israelites complain, God sends venomous snakes
 They repent ... Moses makes bronze snake on a pole
 Whoever LOOKS up at the snake-on-a-pole is HEALED
- 4. Ex. 7:8-13 our passage of the hour ...

Snake on a Pole? ... connects to John 3 & Jesus on the Cross Snake on a Pole?—connects antiquity to TODAY

Greeks call this the Rod of Asclepius, or Staff of Asclepius Wielded by the Greek god Asclepius, god of healing snakes would slither on the floor of Greek medical dormitories Sometimes confused w the Staff of Hermes, the caduceus. Hermes: Greek god who conducted folks into afterlife Staff of Hermes had two snakes wrapped around a winged staff with carvings of the other gods It has been used as the symbol of commerce, too

O.T. scholars Keil and Delitzsch say Exodus 7 is "distinctly related to the art of snake-charming"

of the Psylli in ancient Egypt ... and—perhaps—the Israelites gave the term *tannin* to the snakes used in that "charming"

Psylli = ancient Berber tribe of snake handlers, trained from infancy with snake bites & immune to venom

Snake Charming today in Egypt, Arabia, India Sadly—catch this—in 2011, NPR reported that you're going to love this

Snake Charming in India is a DYING ART ...

Get it ... Dying Art ... hahahaha

BTW Berber Psylli is NOT the origin of SILLY

In his 1845 <u>Egypt & the Books of Moses</u>, German Professor E. W. Hengstenberg said:


In the religious festivals, the Psylli appear entirely naked, with the neck, arms, and other parts of the body coiled around by serpents, which they permit to sting and tear ...

they spit in the throat of the animal, compel it to shut up its mouth, and lay it down upon the ground....


lay their hand upon its head, and immediately the serpent, stiff and motionless, falls into a kind of torpor.


