As shown in *When Texas Prison Scams Religion*, the Norwoods have made a lot of money, pocketing nearly a half million in the first years, according their foundation's Form 990s, and of late refusing to place the top officer salaries on their Form 990s, either from a slick accounting or simple violation of the law that requires the salaries of the top officers.¹
