Ministerial Duties

Aug 97 – present

I was hired as a Senior Pastor of the Fellowship of Huntsville Church in August 1997 and have served in this capacity since arriving. Upon receiving this job the board of the church asked if I desired to remain in my employment with the Texas Department of Criminal Justice and I said I would. Currently there are three full time pastors at the church fulfilling various assignments and the administrative needs of the church. These pastors all three are at the church daily to meet the needs that arise to include a full time administrative assistant in the office. This arrangement has allowed me to fulfill my duties as a bi-vocational senior pastor and to work at the TDCJ, while ensuring the functionality of the church is maintained. I am required to preach at both morning services on Sundays, in addition I teach a bible class between the services. The preaching consists of exegetical preaching to explain the biblical texts from the original language and further explanation of how application of the text is lived out in one's life. I also am trained in counseling and provide counseling in all areas depending on the needs that arise. I also fill in on a Radio program at KHCB Radio Houston monthly and when needed.

Jan. 1998 – Dec. 2004

During this time period I was an adjunct faculty member at the College of Biblical Studies-Houston. I taught an undergraduate night course once a week during this period both Fall and Spring Semesters. I stepped down from this position to lighten my schedule as my normal class size was approx. 35 students and driving to Houston after work weekly for six years became difficult with pastoral and TDCJ duties.

June 1986- August 1997

I served as Senior Pastor of the Weldon Baptist Church for eleven years. While pastoring this church I was able to attend Bible College at night and receive an undergraduate degree in Biblical Studies. I then attended Dallas Theological Seminary by taking classes at the Houston extension. I utilized my summer vacation time to finish my degree during summer intensive courses on the campus in Dallas. I obtained both degrees and additional language studies in Greek and Hebrew. While pastoring the church, attending school, and working with TDCJ was very difficult and required great sacrifice, it proved to be very rewarding also. I was ordained while serving in this church.
